

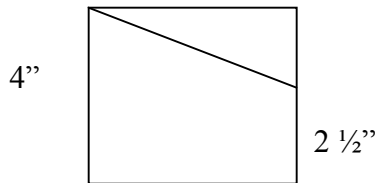

Specifications for ammunition finished packet dimensions (per US Ordnance Manual, 1861):

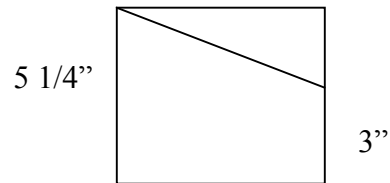
.69 Calibre: 2.6" high X 3.1" wide X 1.35" deep

.58 Calibre: 2.6" high X 2.9" wide X 1.15" deep

Specifications for ammunition tube paper:

.69 Cartridges

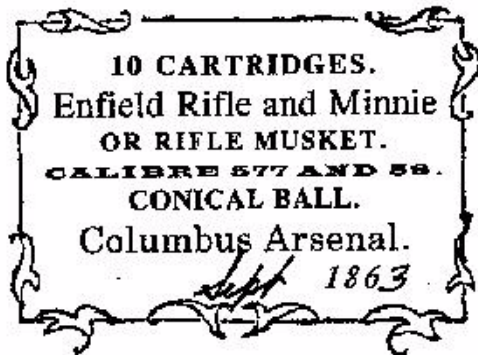
Specifications for ammunition wrapper dimensions:

.69 Calibre: 9" X 6 1/2"

.58 Calibre: 8 1/2" X 5 1/2" works (2 per 8 1/2" by 11" standard sheet)

All Confederate ammunition was supposed to be packed with musket caps, not needed on the label.

Many variations of calibre and bullet type were packaged with the standard Federal bullet label with minor changes only to the text. Cartridges were packed alternating bullet end up and down.
